

Dear traveller, **HEALTH COMES FIRST**



The Peruvian government has taken the following measures against **COVID-19**:

- The State of National Emergency will be in force **until August 31, 2020**, allowing the movement of people from Monday to Saturday from 04:00 to 22:00 hours. A full curfew is in effect on Sundays.
- This measure **does not apply to** the regions of Arequipa, Huánuco, Ica, Junín, Madre de Dios and San Martín, nor in 36 other provinces defined in [Article 2 of Supreme Decree 139-2020-PCM](#), which are in mandatory quarantine. In these areas, people are allowed outside from 04:00 to 20:00 hours, with a full curfew on Sundays.
- During compulsory curfew, staff that provide food supply services, health, medical, financial or restaurant delivery services, among others **are exempted**.
- The use of a **mask in public is mandatory** throughout the country.
